- Coming from the North: RT 66 west to exit 44 (RT 234 South by-pass) to RT 28 South. Travel approximately 15 miles to RT 649 (Germantown Rd. which becomes Midland Rd.) and turn left. Landmark is a silo painted like an ear of corn. Go 7 miles to Lucas farm on the right.
- RT 95 south to exit 143B (Garrisonville Rd. - Rt 610). Follow Garrisonville Road for 10 miles. Rt 610 turns left and becomes Aquia Rd. Turn left and take immediate right fork. Follow 610 for 3 miles to stop sign and turn left. Go a few hundred yards and take hard right. You are still on Rt 610 but it is now called Midland Road. Go approximately 2.5 miles to Lucas farm on left.
- Take RT 95 South or North to exit 133B (RT 17 North toward Warrenton.) Go approximately 17 miles and turn right at the light onto Elk Run Rd. (RT 806).
