Dogs which first qualify at this trial will not be permitted to enter the Limited Stakes.

***Hunting Dog Stake is a non-regular stake where dogs will be judged on their keen desire to hunt. The dog does not need to be broke and can be collared after establishing point. A blank pistol will be fired after each flush, but steadiness to wing is not required.

***Open All Age stake is a money stake. One half of the entry is collected and split among the top 3 placements: 1st place-50%, 2nd place-30%, 3rd place-20%

COURSES AND BIRDS

All stakes are non-retrieving, single course without bird field except Open Limited Gun Dog, Open Limited All Age, and Amateur Walking Gun Dog stakes, which are retrieving stakes which will be handled with call back in designated bird field. Released Quail, Chuker and Pheasant in all stakes. Pigeons may be used for retrieving stakes. A blank pistol will only be fired in the Open Derby and

Amateur Walking Derby. Horseback handling is permitted in all stakes except the Hunting Dog Stake, Amateur Walking Derby, Amateur Walking Puppy, and Amateur Walking Gun Dog.

ONLY AKC APPROVED TRACKING COLLARS PERMITTED.**

From points North and East, take I-95 South to exit 133B and go north on Rt. 17 to just north of Goldvein where you will see a sign for Phelps WMA and Sumerduck. Make a left onto Rt. 651 and go approximately 7.5 miles. The grounds are on the left. This is a HARD turn with a big rig. You can go past the entrance a short way to Rt. 620 which comes in from the left. Turn around and approach from the opposite direction.

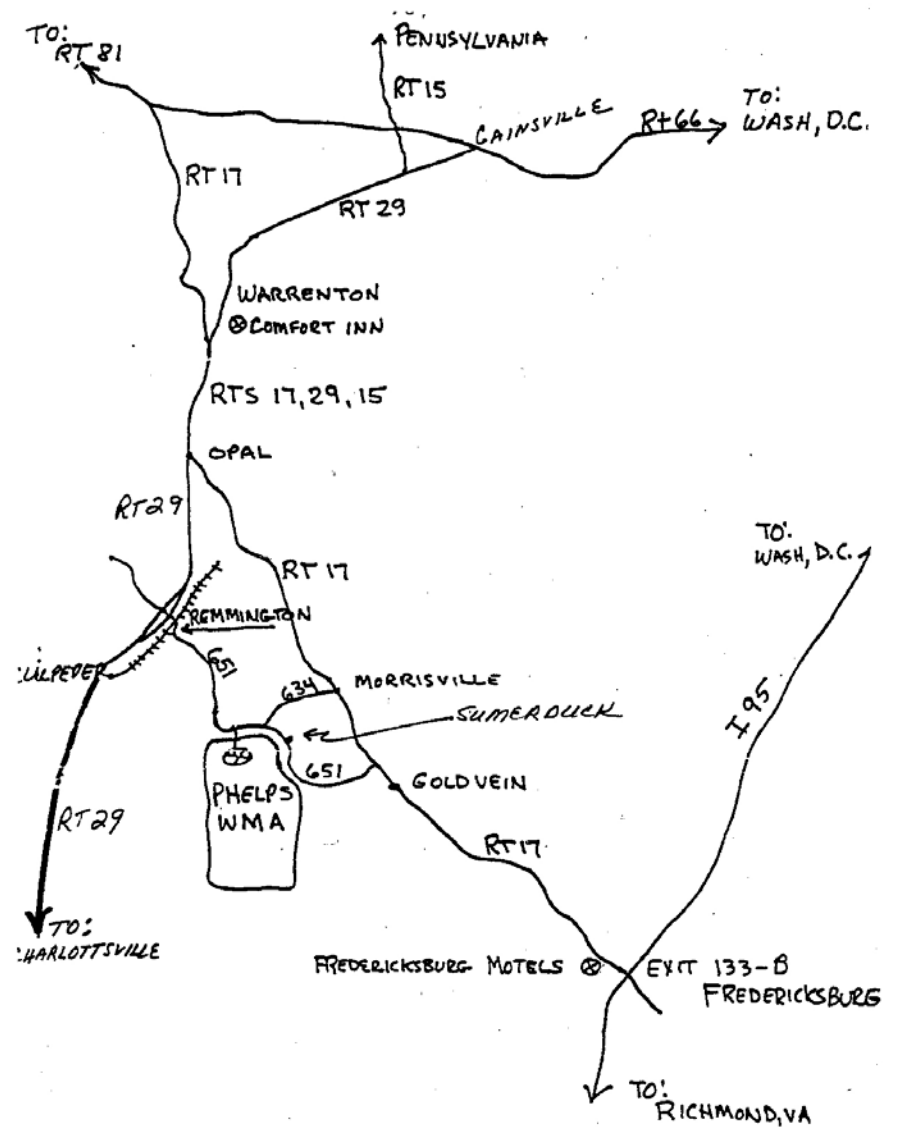
From points North and West, take I-81 to Winchester and pick up Rt. 17 South. Follow Rt. 17 south to Warrenton where it joins Rt. 29 South. Follow Rt. 29 South to Remington. Make a left onto Rt. 651 approximately 5.3 miles to the grounds on the right.

From points South and East, take I-95 North to exit 133B and follow directions above. (North and East directions)

From points South and West, take I-64 to Charlottesville and pick up Rt. 29 North. Follow Rt. 29 North to Remington and follow as above. (North and West directions)
