Versatility Testing - Here's an opportunity to earn a pass on all three areas of the Vizsla Club of America's Versatility Program (field, obedience, & conformation)! Testing will begin no earlier than 8:00am, and will go throughout the day. Test entry fees are: Field - \$22, Conformation & Obedience - \$12 each. VCA Versatility recording fees of \$2 per dog/per test entered are included in the entry fee(s). No charge for Conformation measurement only. Entrants must supply dog's registration info; AKC Reg Name, Sire, Dam, AKC Number, Birth Date, and Breeder Name. Detailed program info can be found at <http://vcaweb.org/versatility.htm>. For your enjoyment, we recommend bringing folding chairs for your use. Ticks are a concern - please dress appropriately and/or take appropriate precautions.

Out of respect for others and the property, we ask you please observe the following:

- Your dog must be under your control **AT ALL TIMES**. It is recommended that you bring a crate or stake-out for your dog for when you cannot be with it.
- No in-season females.
- Pick-up after your dog (we will have waste bags available at the registration desk if you forget yours).
- Your dog may only be off-leash in designated areas. (In order maintain order, we may limit the number of off-leash dogs in any one area at a given time.)

Please remember that while Rose Hill is large, it is not fenced. Dog handlers are urged to use good judgment in deciding to let their dog off-leash even in designated off-leash areas.

Directions:

From Washington, D.C. (Drive time just over an hour):

From 495 take I-66 West and drive 22 miles to exit for Route 29 South. Drive 34 Miles and take Route 3 East. Drive 5 miles then turn right on Batna Road and go 100 yards to Rose Hill Game Preserve on your right.

From Charlottesville (Drive time 45 minutes):

Take 29 North and drive 43 miles then turn right onto Route 3 East. Drive 5 miles to a right on Batna Road. Go 100 yards to Rose Hill Game Preserve on your right.

From Fredricksburg (Drive time about 30 minutes)

From I-95 take Route 3 West for 28 miles. Turn left on Batna Road then go 100 yards to Rose Hill Game Preserve on your right.
