IMPORTANT NEW VIRGINIA LAW!! PLEASE READ!!

Access Permit Effective January 1, 2012

Effective January 1, 2012, the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) requires an Access Permit for visitors to department owned Wildlife Management Areas (WMSs) and public fishing lakes who are age 17 and older, *unless they possess a valid Virginia hunting license, freshwater fishing or trapping license or a current Virginia boat registration.* Daily or Annual Access Permits for WMAs and department owned public fishing lakes statewide are available for purchase online or by calling 1-866-721-6911 or at any licensed agent. Each individual must purchase his/her own permit. CVC cannot do it for you. We have tried. Daily Access Permits can be consecutive up to five days. The cost is \$4 per day. This is a reminder to all who use the Phelps Wildlife Management Area. Phelps WMA is a State owned joint use area. While clubs reserve the barn and eating facility the remainder of the area is still open for others to use. You may encounter hikers, dog walkers, hunters and trail riders. They are here to enjoy the outdoors, not to interrupt the event. When you come upon them, be friendly, treat them with respect and inform them what the event is about and where the course is you are using – and that live ammunition is being used in some stakes. DIRECTIONS

From Interstate I-95, take exit 133 B and go north on Rt 17 to Rt 651 just past Goldvian. Follow 651 about **8 miles** to grounds on the left. If you are pulling a big rig, we suggest you continue on Rt.17 north about 7 more miles to Rt 668, Savannah Branch Rd. Turn left and go 3.1 miles to Rt. 651. Turn left onto 651 and go 2.4 miles to the grounds on the right.

If coming south from Warrenton, follow directions to exit onto Rt. 17 south from right lane at Opal. **Do not try to get on RT 17 south by turning left. The road is blocked. You will have to make a U turn and go back to the light at Opal.** Proceed 8 miles to Savannah Branch Rd. and turn right. Proceed as above.
